



Report on the Global Emerging Leadership Program 2022 conducted at Sairam Campus, Chennai in association with GELP, Canada on 29-11-2022.

Global Emerging Leadership Program (GELP) is a social enterprise aimed at developing leadership programs for students and young professionals. GELP provides professional guidance to students seeking their next post-secondary and career experience. GELP's goal is to promote leadership development and to equip global leaders with the tools to create change and impact within their communities. The Global Marketplace provides an opportunity to help delegates understand the dimensions of leadership through experiential learning and skill-based workshops.





The Global Marketplace Leadership Program 2022 was one of the major international events in Sairam campus in collaboration with the Global Emerging Leadership Program (GELP), Canada. GELP is partnering with Simon Fraser University - Canada, Vancouver

Island University - Canada, and many Canadian universities. More than 20 delegates from Canada visited the college to honor the Global Virtual Summit Winners who won prizes worth \$850 CAD in Global Virtual Summit and to sign an MoU with our institution.

The program was conducted on Tuesday 29th November 2022 with 2500 students from Sri Sairam Engineering College and Sri Sairam Institute of Technology. The event started with the Thamiz Thai Vazthu. It was followed by a Classical dance performance to showcase our tradition. As per the Tamil custom the programme was given an auspicious beginning with Kuthuvilakku being lit by the delegates and the other officials who were on the dais. Our Eminent CEO Dr. Sai Prakash Leo Muthu felicitated the chief guest, Omar Karim, Founder & President, GELP and all other GELP delegates with a garland, shawl and memento as a token of gratitude.



A video on GELP was played to introduce the students to the program. Mr. Omar Karim, Founder and President, Global Emerging Leadership Programs (GELP) welcomed the gathering. The dynamic CEO and Chairman, Sairam Group of Institutions Dr. SaiPrakash LeoMutthu addressed the gathering and inspired the students to make effective use of the platforms provided.
