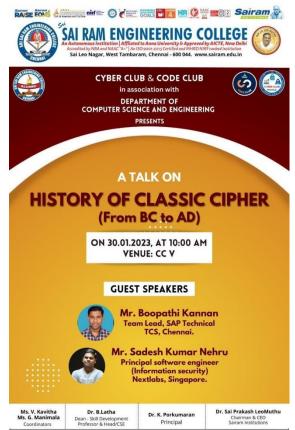
Activity Report of the Code club for the Academic

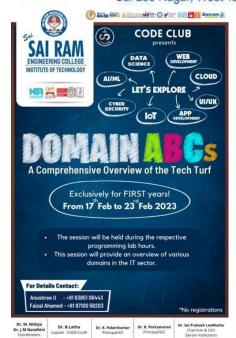
