




INDEPENDANCE DAY: 15 th August 2023

Date: 18th November 2023



Date: 27th November 2023



Date: 1st December 2023



Date: 2nd December 2023



Green Graphics - Sustainable Environment [A poster-making competition].



A fun and intellectually stimulating puzzle-solving game that required participants to decode symbols, riddles, and clues. This event tested logical reasoning and attention to detail


5. Flash Foto

Title: Meeting with the President and Village Ward Members

Details: The UBA coordinator Mr.D.Muralidharan delivered the lecture on the importance of protecting the environment to NCC, UBA and NSS volunteers.
