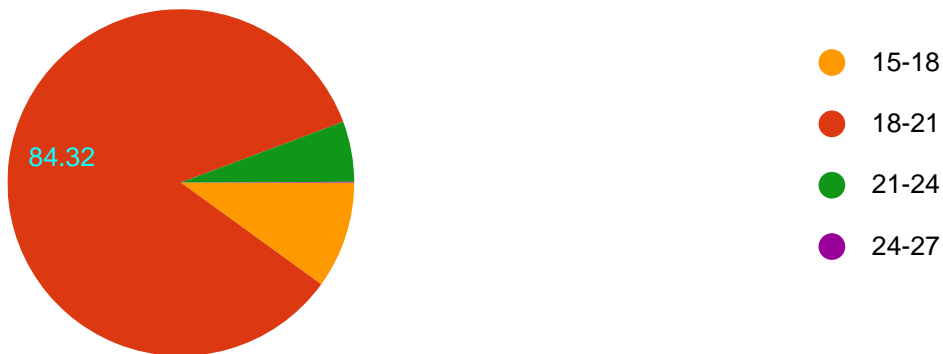

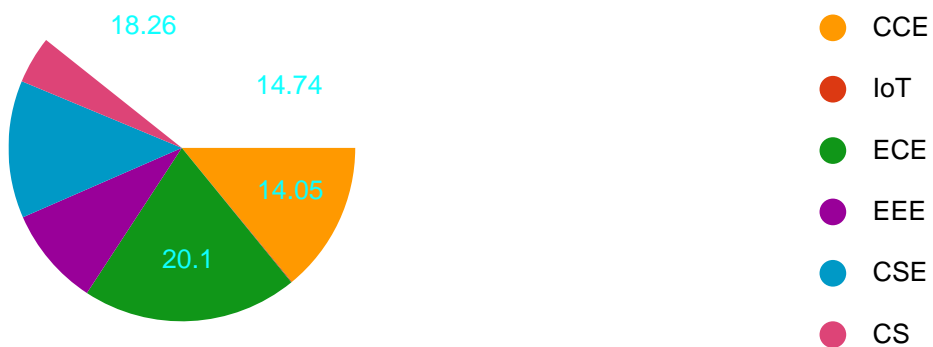

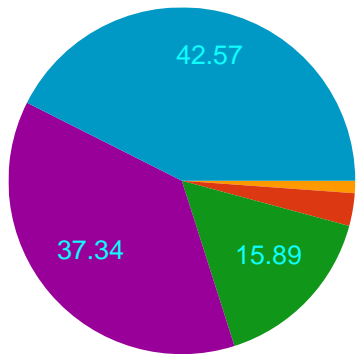

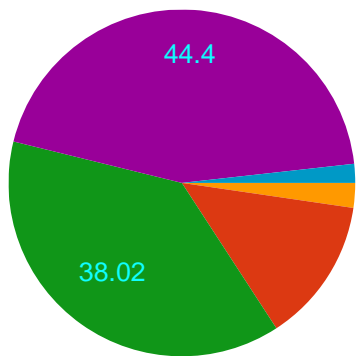

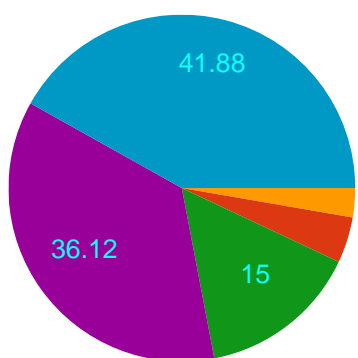

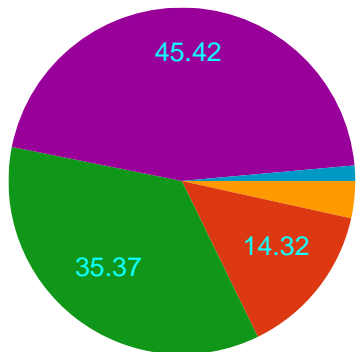

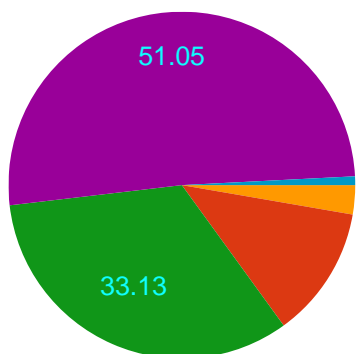

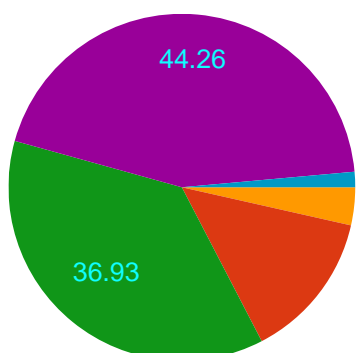

Points Discussed :

- **TEACHERS INFORM YOU ABOUT YOUR EXPECTED COMPETENCIES, COURSE OUTCOMES AND PROGRAMME OUTCOMES.**
- **THE TEACHERS ILLUSTRATE THE CONCEPTS THROUGH EXAMPLES AND APPLICATIONS.**
 - Faculty members are requested to upload the syllabus, including course outcomes and the corresponding knowledge levels, to the GCR.
 - Faculty members are encouraged to use pedagogical tools to effectively explain concepts.
 - Practical-oriented learning, problem-solving sessions, and subject-related video classes should be organized to enhance students' knowledge.
 - The SAIL app should be utilized for conducting objective tests and live assessments, with two objective tests to be conducted for each unit.
 - All lecture materials and lab manuals should be uploaded to the Google Classroom.

- Guest lectures should be organized to cover topics beyond the syllabus. Industry experts should be invited as resource persons to bridge curriculum gaps effectively.

- **PROMOTING INTERNSHIP, STUDENT EXCHANGE, FIELD VISIT OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS.**

- Students are encouraged to participate in in-plant training and internships within their core fields of study, completing a total of 45 days of internship over the four-year course.
